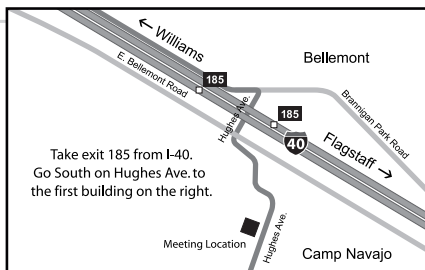


# PUBLIC INFORMATIONAL MEETING

Camp Navajo Open Burn/Open Detonation Closure Project

6 p.m. to 8 p.m. Thursday, June 11, 2009

The public is invited to attend a meeting of the Camp Navajo Stakeholder Advisory Group (SAG). National Guard Bureau and Arizona Army National Guard representatives will present information on the program for investigating and cleaning up sites that were historically used for demilitarization of obsolete and unserviceable munitions. Additionally, Don Bills, a hydrologist with the US Geological Survey, will discuss ongoing groundwater studies in the Williams-Flagstaff area. The SAG is comprised of representatives from various federal, state and local agencies and from the community. The SAG meets tri-annually to discuss the status of the cleanup activities, and all meetings are open to the public. Between meetings, they review and comment on work plans, procedures and reports.
